The meeting was called to order by Chairman Don Mitchell:

1) IC 67-2345(1)(b) – Executive Session

To consider the evaluation, dismissal or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent or public school student.

A motion was made by Byron Burnham and seconded by John Crozier that the Board of Trustees of Jt. Jerome School District #261 recess into executive session in the manner and for the purpose authorized by Section 67-2345(1)(b), Idaho Code, regarding personnel issues involving certified employees of the district.
