The telephone conference meeting was called to order by Chairman Don Mitchell at 1:00 p.m.:

- 1) Executive Session IC 67-2345(1)(b) – Student – to consider the evaluation, dismissal or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent, or public school student.
 - i) Student Discipline

A motion was made by John Crozier and seconded by Byron Burnham that the Board of Trustees of Jt. Jerome School District #261 recess into executive session in the manner and for the purpose authorized by Section 67-2345(1)(b), Idaho Code, regarding district student issues involving students of the district.
