NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the patrons of school district No. 261, that a special meeting of the Board of Trustees of said district was called to be held at 7:00 p.m. at the Jerome High School Crowder Memorial Library, 104 North Tiger Drive, Jerome, on December 3, 2013. The meeting was called to order by Superintendent Dale Layne:

1) Participation and discussion at the Jerome School District Facilities Advisory Committee meeting. Chris Bragg, Co-Chairman of the Facilities Advisory Steering Committee, began the meeting with a presentation identifying the areas of need, safety, security and overcrowding issues for students and schools in the district; reviewed the proposed expansions and changes at each school; outlined the costs of the projects; and summarized plans to present the bond request to patrons. Beth Mower led the group discussion about committee organization and a brief question and answer period followed.

The Facilities Advisory Committee agreed on a name change to the name that was used during the last bond campaign. The committee will be referred to as Citizens For Better Schools.

The next Jerome School District Facilities Advisory Committee meeting is scheduled for January 7, 2014, at 7:00 p.m.
