The Jerome School District #261 provides educational services for children with disabilities residing in the Jerome School District boundaries.

If you suspect an infant, child, or young adult of having a developmental delay or disability, we can open a window of hope for a brighter future! The individual may be eligible for services, at no cost, under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)



Services are available to eligible individuals from birth through age 21 identified with a disability who may be experiencing difficulties in one of or more of the following:

*Physical Disability
Speech/Language
Learning Disability
Visual Impairment
Intellectual Disability*

*Emotional Disturbance
Deaf or Hard of Hearing
Autism
Other Health Impairment
Deaf-Blind*
